

Visit the following subject matter experts and info booths throughout the event:

- The **Biobank Portal** is a tool that links consented subjects from the Partners Biobank with their health care data from the electronic medical record (EMR).
- Brigham Research Education Program: The Research Education Program works
  closely with other groups providing education and training for the BWH research
  community to help promote all offerings across the continuum.
- Brigham Research Institute (BRI): BRI strives to provide a clear voice (internally and externally) for the entire BWH research community, raise the profile of research at BWH, develop mission-centric collaborations with external entities and engage the scientific community in fundraising.
- ERIS **Consumer Technology Management (CTM)**: This team was formed to create synergy between PC, Mac, and Mobile teams to unify and operationalize the endpoint computing strategy. CTM is working on the new Partners PC with Windows 10.
- **Dropbox Business** allows individuals and teams to sync, share, and manage your files online. Up to 1 TB of storage is provided per user, full data encryption and compliance with Partners policies and procedures, including use for Protected Health Information (PHI). Stop by to learn how to make the most of this collaboration tool.
- ERIS Enterprise Mobility Management (EMM): Keeping mobile devices secure is an
  important security initiative. Partners has successfully enrolled over 30,000 users in
  MobileIron, which ensures that Partners resources, such as email, are secured on mobile
  devices. Stop by to see a demo and ask questions.
- Freezerworks is an electronic sample and specimen management and tracking tool developed by Dataworks and hosted through Enterprise Research IS at Partners HealthCare. The application meets GLP and FDA Guidelines, including 21 CFR part 11 requirements for labs across the Partners network.
- ERIS Integrated Data Environment for Analytics (IDEA) is an analytics platform for machine learning and natural language processing across very large and unstructured datasets in a Hadoop environment.

- LabArchives: An electronic laboratory notebook solution for organizing and securely sharing laboratory data within your study team, department or external collaborators.
- Mobile Applications Process Coordinator (MAPC) reviews digital health technologies and ensures that the PI and Study Team are in touch with all relevant stakeholders in a timely manner for a successful implementation. Learn when, and how, to request a Digital Health Technology Review, and what to expect.
- The **Research Data Protection Office (RDPO)** works with the Brigham Health Research Community to secure system and network resources and maintain the confidentiality, integrity, and availability of research data.
- Research Electronic Data Capture (REDCap) & Survey tool: A web-based software application for electronic collection and management of research and clinical study data.
- ERIS **Research Computing Core**: Learn about storage, backup, and cost-effective consultation and technical services. Learn about how to access discounted academic software for business use.
- Research Patient Data Registry (RPDR): The Research Patient Data Registry (RPDR) is a centralized clinical data registry or data warehouse that gathers clinical information from various Partners hospital systems.
- ERIS **RICS Office**: RICS provides dedicated computing support for the research community at Brigham and Women's Hospital (BWH). The RICS team helps researchers focus on science by solving their IT challenges using their deep knowledge of Research IT across the system to consult on solutions for researchers.
- ERIS **Scientific Computing**: Learn about the computational resources available to you. For example, ask your questions about the ERISOne Linux Cluster and the newly-formed Partners R User Group as well as Python Training.
- ERIS **Web Hosting**: ERIS provides hosting options for lab and departmental websites on both shared hosting environments like Wordpress or on a dedicated Virtual Server (VM).

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
